Notes to Editors:

Specifically highlighted in the Address to the Annual General Meeting of Seeing Machines made by the Company's Chairman, Fulton Muir were the following key points:

- The company achieved its best ever results for the year ended 30 June 2006:
 - Revenue up 70% to A\$2.4 million
 - After-tax loss of A\$135,077 down 89% on the previous year's loss of \$1.228 million
 - Cash reserves of A\$2.4 million up 263% on the previous year
- The sale of the faceLAB product has been largely responsible for the revenue growth in the past year. It continues to be sold to many prestigious institutions involved in R&D including motor vehicle manufacturers, universities and defence organisations.
